We will cross to the other side to take the path that goes to the chapel of San Paio.

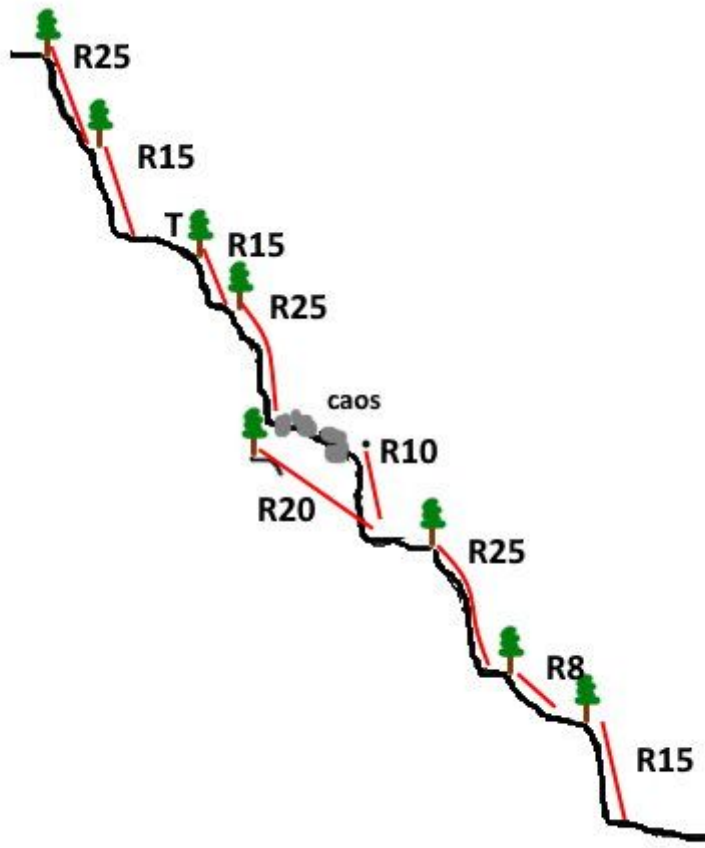
