We must get to Yeste for it by the A30 take exit 56 to the CM412. We will continue until after Elche de la Sierra that we will take a detour to the left to the CM3206 to Yeste.

At the exit of Yeste we take the detour to the left to the A63 to La Graya. We will pass the Alcantarilla turnoff leaving it on the right and shortly after a bridge over the Segura and a road that goes up to the village of Chorreones. We can park here or go up the road to Chorreones about 1km to a track on the right and park up here.

From the parking lot below we will go up the road to P2.

In both cases we will take the track that goes to the right and we will follow it until it gets lost, we will follow the torrentera until the top where we will see a track, from here the descent to the riverbed is clear.

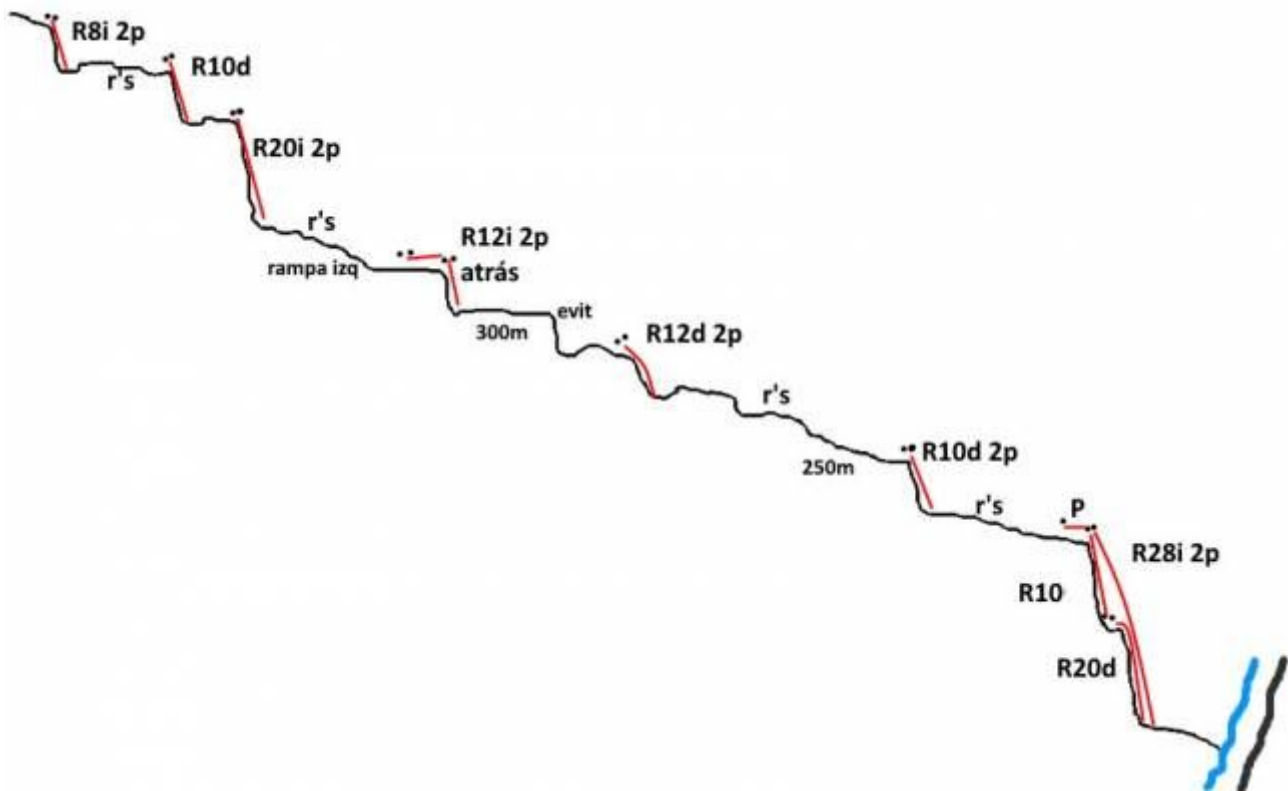
