Summary: (machine translated) Also known as Barranco de Mozul, although for us it is misnamed, since the Mozul stream runs parallel to this ravine to the south. Toponymic disquisitions aside, this is a simple ravine of initiation with rappels of up to 10m and some very well formed narrows. Generally it does not carry water, but the marmitas can maintain it almost all the year, reason why we will find handrails in several parts of the route to avoid getting into the stagnant waters.		
Hydrology: No		
Access: (machine translated) Take the CV35 towards Tuejar. If we go from Valencia, past the gas station we have on the right the Mancomunidad del Alto Turia and the detour to the right to the source of Tuejar. We take this small road, and continue to the hostel. Here we leave the dam on the left and continue along the road straight ahead. This track crosses the river several times. There comes a moment, after 6kms of track that separates a little from the river and makes a bend over the Mozul stream and 200m later we have the Ahillas stream on our right. If we pass a few meters we have a characteristic crossing of tracks.		
Approach: (machine translated) We will leave by the old track that goes up the stream on the orographic right, it rises until it stops at another track, we take it to the right and we follow it always with the ravine on our right. After about a kilometer and a half a detour that we take to the right takes us down to an old dam / dam, through here we access		
Tour: (machine translated) We will start from the dike, then we will be careful not to slip on the cliffs of this beautiful canyon until we reach the rope that allows us to climb to the left ledge. The rest is handrails, cliffs and some rappels without difficulty. Very aesthetic		
Return: (machine translated) We will follow the course to the car
