<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) This canyon runs along the outlet of the Mulato reservoir and can therefore carry significant flows. The longest rappel, the first one, can be avoided by going down the wall, the rest is a succession of rappels, slides and jumps. Be careful with the depths of the pools, which vary considerably. Better after rains, with good flow to be able to take advantage of jumps and slides. Recommended combination of vehicles, recently re-equipped by the town hall of Mogán.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> Difíciles		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) In Mogán, take the GC200 northbound to Pie de la Cuesta. Location of Mogán Take the GC605 road to the Mulato dam and the Las Niñas dam. After 3 km we cross the bed of the ravine and soon we arrive at the Fte Guirrerera, here we will park the return vehicle in one of the small lay-bys of the road. With the access vehicle we will climb another 4km to the height of the dam, in the right curve we get to the left and park here next to the fence without disturbing.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Access to Mogán From the upper parking lot is immediate and intuitive, we will follow the track to the dam, we can go down the stairs or on one side there is an installation for abseiling of 35m.

<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) At the end of the riverbed we follow the riverbed and turn left onto a path that leads to the road.


