River walk that becomes increasingly attractive as it progresses and opens up some possible jumps.

### **Hydrology:**

Access: (machine translated)

From Kas we take the state road 400 in the direction of Antalya. After about 7 km, shortly before reaching the village of Agilli, we take a sharp left turn off the 400 towards Orttakuyu and the ancient town of Phellos (brown sign). After about 1 km, a small tarred road turns off to the right in a northerly direction (towards Pinarbasi). We pass through Pinarbasi and reach the heights about 7 km after turning off the 400. Now it's another 3 km downhill and we drive through Dereköy. 50 m after the mosque on the right-hand side we come to the bridge over the Hacioglan. We park the lower vehicle here.

We continue with the second vehicle on the orographic left bank of the Hacioglan and reach Ugrar 6 km after Dereköy. We keep left here and turn left a little further north in the direction of Sinneli. We drive through a small settlement (Cataoluk) on the western edge, turn left before Sinneli and the new road takes us up the northern slope high above the river Hacioglan. After a good 8 kilometers, we turn left off the new road, reach the scattered settlement of the same name (around 25 km from Dereköy) and drive down to the river. We park the second car at the bridge.

#### **Approach:** (machine translated)

We now follow the track along the orographic right bank of the stream downhill in an easterly direction. Where the track turns away from the stream and begins to climb, we take the forest path to the left and always follow the stream. Several crossings of the stream follow, the path becomes a goat track and finally gets lost. Then we come to the first narrow section between solid rock and a longer swim. Here begins the actual canyoning route.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Also a lot of walking after the first swim, but in the last third attractive ambience with some possible jumps.

**Return:** (machine translated)

After crossing the final rock bar, follow the stream to the road bridge. About 200m before the bridge you can already go out to the right on a dirt road.
