Given the prohibition to do the upper part because it belongs to the protected area of Picos de Europa, we can do the following two parts, combining them with each other or with the ravines of Navedo and Cicera.

The intermediate part has only two obligatory rappels of 7m with very short access, route and return. In total less than 3 hours.

The lower part, although longer, is equally simple but with a final rappel of 25m and a longer route that requires a combination of vehicles.

It is advisable to avoid the summer unless it has rained because it can have little water and be stagnant.

Corvera 3 difficult exit through the middle of the mountain.

Location of the Hermida ravines

From San Vicente de la Barquera or from Potes we take the N621 to La Hermida.

Location Corvera 1, 2 and 3

In La Hermida we will leave the car to return to Corvera 3.

Turn right towards Bejes. After the first bridge over the river we can park the access car to Corvera 3.

We continue along the road and at the next bridge we have the exit to Corvera 2.

A little further up, after the sharp bends we will see a house on the right and a road, here we reach the access bridge to Corvera 2.

Simple, the only complication would be with high flow rates.

In the case of Corvera 2 by the road bridge, if we only have one car we will have to go up to the access car.

In the case of Corvera 3 we leave to the left, by the mill and from here to the road right in La Hermida.
