### **Access:** (machine translated)

Leave the N-I highway (Gasteiz/Vitoria - Pamplona) at exit 389 to Egino (Eguino) to the north. Do not enter the town, but when you reach the houses, take the A-3012 road to the left (west) in the direction of Ibardua. About 700 m after Egino and about 100 m before reaching Ibardua, a sign 'Leze' points to the right and after about 400 m we reach a sparse deciduous forest with parking and picnic areas. Here we park the car in the designated parking lot.

### **Approach:** (machine translated)

From the car (about 630 m above sea level), we head towards a chute in the rock face to the west of the large, elongated cave opening. We briefly ascend along the edge of the chute over a rocky ridge secured by a wire rope, then the trail crosses an old water pipe and we reach the ridge above the rock face. We now follow the path for about 15 minutes towards the striking gulch on the ridge above us (Brecha Koloska). Before it gets really steep, at an altitude of about 750 m to 800 m above sea level, we take a path (sometimes only indistinct climbing tracks) that leads us up to the right in an easterly direction to the ridge at about 1000 m above sea level. We cross the ridge to the north (not to the northeast!), descend steeply and then descend pathless to the northwest in the hollow on the other side of the ridge. We finally come to a ledge where we can see through the trees to the northern opening of the cave. We reach the cave entrance either by rappelling in the left-hand chute or by rappelling/abseiling in the steep cirque to the right of the cave entrance (approach time about 1.5 hours). The Internet sites describe a path several times, which at the beginning is oriented more eastwards and seems more pronounced. Gomez only turns right (or left) shortly before Brecha Koloska.

There is also an extreme ascent and especially descent through the Brecha de la Koloxka:

Access is made easier with the ability to orient yourself.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

13 rappels, most of them in the dark. The cave stretches across the ridge in the form of the entrance and exit opening. Intense impressions regarding the sounds and the (indirect) incidence of light. The water flow is generally moderate. Do not enter if there is a threat of thunderstorms. Do not enter during thunderstorms.

At the cave exit left to the picnic areas and the car.
