A different way to access the Peonera Inferior. A first part without much grace until arriving at its end in which it opens vertiginously on the Alcanadre in a jump of 40m that we will have to rappel.

It is possible to be carried out all the year, the problem is in the Peonera and its flow.

Access: (machine translated)

Take the highway from Huesca to Barbastro at exit 77 towards Abiego/Alquézar. Arriving at Abiego turn towards Bierge on the A1227.

Parking Peonera Inferior

Bierge towards Rodellar on the HU341, before pk 6 we have a right turn and on the left the Peonera parking lot.

For the other possible parking (better with 4x4 or high vehicle) we must go to pk 8, where is the parking of Cueva Cabrito, on the other side (on the left) there is a track towards the Alcanadre to an old corral where we can park.

Approach: (machine translated)

Access to Loma Güerga and San Juan

From the parking of the Peonera we will leave by the track that goes to the north parallel to the road. After 500m there is a track to the left along the hill that separates the ravines of San Juan and Loma Güerga. We will go down here for a little more than a kilometer until an abandoned track on the right that will bring us closer to the riverbed.

From the corral we will see a path to go down to the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

A first part along the dry riverbed with a lot of vegetation that does not contribute anything but as we approach the gorges of the Peonera, our canyon will close a little and fall on it with a couple of short rappels before its magnificent R40.

Return: (machine translated)

We will continue along the Peonera to its normal access and return through here. We also have the option of doing Peonera...
