Summary: (machine translated) Very nice, narrow, stratified limestone canyon; several entry and exit points; several narrow places; two siphons which are no problem at normal water level; very grippy rock; many small downclimb/slide and possible jumps; suitable for beginners; clean water; very well equipped.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Belluno in the direction of la Secca. Park the shuttle car in la Secca. Continue with the second car on the SS51. Before KmVIII 29 turn sharp right towards Cornolade (small passage under the railroad). Then follow the mountain road uphill (past Agriturismo Cornolade). Shortly afterwards, cross the Maggiore. Just before a stone bridge, turn left towards Vornolade Alte. Turn right uphill before the next small bridge with green railings. Park at the second hairpin bend (approx. 300m further on).		
Approach: (machine translated) Directly at the second hairpin bend, follow the well-trodden path over the first small stream/river. Then climb up a little on the orographic left-hand side next to the Val Maggiore until you reach a well-trodden path that soon leads directly to the stream. This is the entry point for the Maggiore intermedio (there are several entry options, but we found this one to be the best).		
Tour: (machine translated) The Val Maggiore is a not deeply incised (max. 40m) canyon in very beautiful, grippy layered limestone in a vegetation-rich environment. Countless beautifully washed-out pools, some of which are deep, invite you to slide or jump after checking the depth. As the canyon is often used commercially, the tour is well equipped. There are Inox lugs, chain anchors, glued anchors or rope traverses for rappels or bypassing at all important steps/spots. The Val Maggiore is suitable for beginners, but should not be underestimated at higher water levels as some pools can recede or you may have difficulty getting out in the washouts/caves in the current area. The highest abseil point of 25m comes after a short warm-up section directly after the bridge that you have previously passed by car (there are often onlookers on a viewing platform). The 25m rappel can also be bypassed on the left. Another higher (15m) rappel comes in the final section under a bridge where you can alternatively get off. Here you should watch out for several iron bars in the stream. The last step before the road can usually be jumped (otherwise chain anchors on the left).		
Return: (machine translated) After the last steps, go through a large pipe underneath the road bridge. The shuttle car is located immediately afterwards.
