We will continue until past Elche de la Sierra that we will take a detour to the left to the CM3206 (Yeste). Once in Yeste, at the exit we will take the detour to Gontar (A63) and continue until the Charca de las Juntas, after crossing the bridge over the Segura we turn right to Miller. When we reach the village we will continue to the upper part of the village.<br>For the return car we return to the Charca de Juntas and turn right before the bridge, go up the Segura and pass the Peguera turnoff.
