#### **Summary:** (machine translated)

Short canyon in the Belluno National Park (canyoning prohibited!); mostly two old 8mm pitons with slings; some nice pools that invite you to jump or slide; clean water; narrow adventurous access path with deep views; large spiders; tick area; canyon is deeply cut; water drainage in the lower part; good to combine with Val de Piero.

## **Hydrology:**

#### Access: (machine translated)

From Belluno on the SS203 direction Agordo. In Cordevole valley at the locality "La Stanga" (Km VII 13) park at the homonymous restaurant (large parking lot on the left after the restaurant).

#### **Approach:** (machine translated)

Directly behind the restaurant, briefly follow the steep path no. 502 to a water house with an antenna. At the inconspicuous crossroads, follow the path/trail to the left behind the little house. The path is initially consistently steep and runs parallel to the road upwards. From the rock face onwards, the path becomes increasingly exposed. From here, the path runs parallel far above the canyon to the entry at approx. 600m (if the path is very wet or someone is not free from giddiness, access can be a problem).

### **Tour:** (machine translated)

After the adventurous access, the most beautiful slides/jumps are just around the corner. If you don't want to jump/slide here, you can also rappel. Caution! Be sure to check all pools beforehand. The canyon has been sufficiently equipped and should also be possible at higher water levels. However, there is no emergency exit as the gorge walls lead vertically upwards for 200-300m in most places. In the first half there are almost all abseiling points up to a maximum of 25m. After the last high approx. 20m abseil, a large clamping block/rock on the right must be climbed over. After that, the canyon is just a hiking canyon up to the dam wall. At the dam wall, you can rappel on the right or downclimb on the left at the water drainage. There is a small ladder on the left where you can get out or you can make a 5m jump into the last beautiful pool before the road bridge.

#### **Return:** (machine translated)

To get back to the parking lot less conspicuously, it is best to walk under the road bridge to the riverbed. Then turn left and shortly back to the parking lot.
