Summary: (machine translated) Also known as "Barranco del pasillo", it is a torrential ravine that is best done with water. In summer it is usually dry and the pools with cloudy water.

Access: (machine translated) By the A-7 exit 448 to take the N340 towards Benahadux. At the first traffic circle third exit to A348 to Alhama. We enter by the first entrance and go around the village by the street that goes south to a traffic circle that we take to the left to head towards the stream. The track crosses the stream, here we can see if it carries water, and continues upwards, after a sharp bend we will see a place on the left to park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Soon we will see on our right a track that goes towards the ravine, we follow it until it ends and we continue along a path, which through the cut, goes to the head of the ravine.		
Tour: (machine translated) After 100m with a lot of vegetation we find the first rappel, from here we will have to pay attention to the state of the pools to decide whether or not to use the handrails that avoid them.		
Return: (machine translated) When we reach the pipeline bridge, we turn right and go up the slope in search of the asphalt road we have been following.
