We must go to Nueno.

On the A23 from Huesca to Jaca, take exit 372 to Arascués/Nueno, cross the bridge over the highway and head for Nueno. After one kilometer we will see a detour to the left to the urbanization Parque Guara, we take it. We will continue straight ahead to the urbanization, leaving the golf course on the left, then we will go around the urbanization by the track that goes straight ahead. When we are going around the north side we will have to cross a small ravine and continue more or less straight ahead towards a track that leads us to cross the Bco Venia, once we have crossed this second ravine we will have a track on the right hand side going uphill that will bring us closer to the Paridera, where we will park.

From the Paridera we will leave towards the West by a track that in about 600m will take us to a path that heads north towards the headwaters. It is better to take track because it is quite losing the path.
