Summary: (machine translated) Well-formed little canyon, with a couple of very entertaining gorges, that we will have to do after heavy rains to find it with water. Facilities in natural or precarious ... it is a collection canyon.		
Hydrology: Sí		
Access: (machine translated) We have to be in the region of Quirós and go to the village of Tene. It can be reached by the AS228 through Proaza or by the AS229 from La Pola. When we reach the Valdemurrio reservoir we have the village of Las Agüeras and next to it the detour to Tene. We will go up and park at the entrance, next to the containers.		
Approach: (machine translated) We leave by the track on the right, we make a sharp left turn and 100m later there is a path to the right that first goes up the slope and then heads west to get into the valley of our descent. The trail is approaching the stream, when we see that it is feasible to go down we will descend to the riverbed. If we follow it all the way we reach the height of the dry creek.
