**Hydrology:** (machine translated)

Very difficult to estimate. There's a big glacier at the top, but a lot of it goes underground. What's important is that the glacial lake, which makes a tidal wave every year, is already empty!

Access: (machine translated)

You can drive to the Simmenfälle restaurant by car. Then cycle to the Sibe Brünne.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Follow the hiking trail up to the Flueseeli, and then past the Flueseehöri, down the scree slope to the start of the Trüebbach gulch.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

At the beginning, the cut is not so deep, but now and then there are beautiful zebra rocks, up there you can still get out of the water, but unsure whether you can get out of the wall. Towards the bottom, the gulch becomes more and more massive, and then there is only one way: down.

The tour is not recommended when the water level is high, as there are several vertical rappels that become extremely narrow over several meters.

**Return:** (machine translated)

First briefly over the scree, into the forest, and then follow the path back to the Sibe Brünne.
