Gear: Ropes: 2x 80m		
Summary: (machine translated) Upper part of the Usedi, many diagonal ropes and narrow parts. Take care, with a lot of water a very strenuous tour because 800hm without possible exit.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) It is best to wait a week after a big storm.		
Access: (machine translated) Pass Chironico and park at Grumo.		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the hiking trail up to A Garnei and then take the only path that leads down into the valley. The trail is sometimes quite overgrown. At p. 1794 the path crosses a stream, which is the start of the tour.		
Tour: (machine translated) At the beginning there are many long slabs where you often have to look for the anchors. After that, the rappels become narrow, without the canyon being cut much. Later, a few tributaries from the right, and more and more a grandiose canyon.		
Return: (machine translated) Orographically take the entry of the Inferiore on the right, or continue with inferiore to the road.
