Location of Calera del Prado

We arrived at Lanestosa by the N629, in the pk 61.2 in a turn with some houses we have the detour to Calera del Prado. We continue to the village and park in the square or next to the church.

Calera river ravines and their accesses

Next to the church there is a path to the left that goes up the slope and turns to the right to head towards the head of the ravine. We follow the track up to a hut and from here it becomes a path. After 400m it turns left and heads towards the stream over some waterfalls. This is the moment to enter the riverbed

Tour: (machine translated)

Very short, we have a first jump/rapel of about 3 meters, then a slide of 5-6 meters and finally the two rappels. The biggest of 12-13m.

We can continue along the creek but it is quite slippery or exit to the right in search of the path uphill.
