Summary: (machine translated) Also known as Doncella ravine It is an aquatic ravine located in an incomparable setting. Otonel is a hamlet of the town of Cortes de Pallas (Valencia). This village, currently uninhabited, was an important urban center in the past. Its famous "chorradores", its jumps, slides and its 60-meter waterfall make it a must for canyoning lovers.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Almost all along the route		
Access: (machine translated) We must approach Millares or Dos Aguas By the CV580 that joins both localities at the height of the kilometer 53 comes out a small road along the mountainside towards Otonel. We continue until a detour that says "Otonel" to the left. If we have two cars with the return car we go to the right to the Cavera bridge with its 30m imposing over the ravine. 500m further on there is a track to the right where we park. We take the access car to the left and climb a little more than 1km to a dirt road that goes to the right and down to the dam. Before the dam there is a place to park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Access with two cars is immediate. With a single car, if we leave it at the exit, we will have to either look for a hidden path that goes up to the dam or go along the road for 4kms.		
Tour: (machine translated) Open ravine mostly of limestone tuff and travertine with waterfalls lined with green mosses and lichens. After heavy rains we can find the first rappel with water and full marmita (value flow in this case). The 60m rappel can be divided into R50 and R10. It is the only section without leaks of the whole descent and the only one that can present complications in case of strong flow.		
Return: (machine translated) A rocky area on the left hand side where we go up to a track that crosses a tunnel, we continue along the track until we reach the road.
