From Schwyz, drive in the direction of Ibergeregpass. Park 750m after the windstock restaurant in the hairpin bend (alt. 915m).

**Approach:** (machine translated)

The canyon begins at the bridge on the road below the parking lot. So at best, path down to the mountain stream or walk around it on the road.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Canyon, which consists of two smaller parts. The first part starts at the bridge (alt. 890m) and exits at the bridge (alt. 850m) and is 160m long. Several small obstacles are lined up in a small indentation. There is a nice T5. After this part, you leave RD and walk along the edge of the forest along the stream and get back into the water at the bridge (alt. 815m) for the second part.

This second part is less well equipped, consisting of waterfalls of greater height. A first C25, AN wide RG, then a chute AN RD leading to a high RD relay for a final C30. Another 2-3 jumps and you arrive at the top of a large slab (60-80m?) which is slightly hollowed out. You can descend this slab using AN RD or leave RD on the path leading to a hay hut.

Numerous escape routes possible.

3.5 km<sup>2</sup> catchment area with wetlands. Possible from spring and quickly after rainfall.

**Return:** (machine translated)

From the hay hut, head up along the edge of the forest along the RD canyon to the bridge of part 2. Cross it and stay on the hiking trail that leads up to the bridge (910 m above sea level) and take the path on the left back to the parking lot.

To continue with the CHLINGENOBEL canyon, cross the bridge that begins part 2, continue on the path and then turn right onto a path that goes over a hut and up the CHLINGENOBEL stream in the forest. Descend as best you can to the mountain stream.
