Largely open rappel canyon with many possible jumps.

Access: (machine translated)

From Castellane (on the Verdon above the Gorges du Verdon) on the D 4085 ("Route Napoleon") in the direction of Digne-les_Bains we drive in serpentines northwestward uphill. Over the Col de Leveque and past the hamlet of Taulann we reach after about 12 km the striking rock breakthrough at the entrance of the Clue de Taulanne.

Approach: (machine translated)

Get in directly under the rock breakthrough of the road (painted on the left on the rock "CANYONING INTERDIT" - now quite faded). But it is still forbidden!

Tour: (machine translated)

Attractive canyon: sunlit, as it faces south-north; one rumbly slide and 2-3 possible jumps (watch out pools look deeper than they are), nice ambiance (deep green pools; entire watercourse sintered).

Return: (machine translated)

After the last waterfall (the next one after the highest rappel - C 25), follow the streambed to the left for a long time without a path, then finally descend to the right on a dirt road to the car at the bridge.

There is also the possibility of climbing up to the right towards the campsite relatively soon after leaving the stream, but this ascent track is not easy to recognize as such (then of course the lower vehicle would also have to be parked there).
