A descent to be made with good flow, it does not dry out but when there is a trickle of water it is not of great interest. In the words of EC/DC "designed for locals". Five rappels, the longest of 33m in ramp, open, with the return path next to it, which allows us to escape at all times.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

Yes at all times to the right to the return path.

Access: (machine translated)

On the AG64 exit As Ponte de García Rodríguez.

We go around the south side of the village to go to the AC101, along the beach of the reservoir and continue north to Ortigueira.

When arriving at p.k. 7 we have the detour to the right to Somede, through here another 3km and we arrive at the detour to the church and Aldeia de Abaixo. We leave this junction behind and continue along the road for another 500m, after the left curve the forest begins on our right and here we have a place to park.

Approach: (machine translated)

We will see a trail that goes off to the right, through the forest to go down to the stream. It is almost immediately

Tour: (machine translated)

Five rappels, the longest of which is 33m on a ramp, open, with the return path next to it, allowing us to escape at all times.

Return: (machine translated)

After the last difficulty, we turn right onto the path that runs parallel to the descent, when we reach the head of the path we will retrace the access path.
