Summary: (machine translated) Dry but very entertaining canyon in the area of Montserrat. We can return by the ferrata next to the canyon of Lloro and Trago and even combine them, it is a complete activity to spend the whole day.		
Hydrology: No		
Access: (machine translated) On the A2 we will take the detour to El Bruc. Cross the village up to the schools and turn right looking for the Refugi Vincenç Barré. We will follow this road that will become a track to the parking lot used by climbers. Another option is to park in Can Maçana (paid parking) or on the road (beware of friends of others).		
Approach: (machine translated) By the path of the white marks, soon a fork with a path of blue marks which we will follow until a hill where we go down the path on the right and the next detour the same to reach the shelter. We will follow the trail and soon another detour to the right until we find a large cairn and a little marked trail to the right that goes down a gully. Follow this path until the beginning of the descent. If we go from Can Maçana we take the path that goes up to the Portella and from there to the Refugi Vincenç Barré, we will pass the pass and the next watercourse is our ravine.		
Tour: (machine translated) A first zone of skills to get into the gorge, then we enter the vertical zone that leads us to the chaos above the chimney where we rappel inside.		
Return: (machine translated) Option 1, we will leave to the right by a path of red marks towards the coll del Xincarró following this path we will stop at the access track. Option 2, we leave to the left under the walls to go to the exit of the Trago and Lloro oxbow, just below surrounding some rocks we have a via ferrata that raises us to the side of the Lloro, which we could do it again. We will continue up next to the Lloro's ox (quite marked and with milestones) until we reach the main path that we will take to the left to the Refugi. We will retrace the rest of the path to Can Maçana.
