La Ciotat, Route de Notre Dame. Attention, the street is closed to traffic, except for residents behind the residences of the Garde :-)

Approach: (machine translated)

At the exit of the road, the canyon below begins. Walk down the road to find a path (signs) that allows you to bypass a first part overgrown with brush.

Tour: (machine translated)

2-3 waterfalls less than 10 m high, then it really gets going with C15+C25 in succession. Reach a ledge and then cross the ropeway.

- Important: The ropes were replaced in May 2018. Bring a double pulley to cross the cableway on the 12 mm stainless steel rope installed by the mountain guide office to keep it in good condition for as long as possible.
- The fixed ropes are replaced regularly according to their wear and tear. Nevertheless, it is important to check their condition.
- Please leave the equipment in place (ropes, stainless steel links, stainless steel plates).

Caution: The ropes must not be left in the sea, otherwise they will be blocked by the current.

Another risk: even if the canyon is dry, the sea must not be too rough as it is very difficult to reach the ledge below the C25.

We strongly advise against doing this type of route in easterly, south-easterly or mistral winds, as well as in even moderate swell. The risk of being swept away by a wave is high.

Return: (machine translated)

It is quite complex and at the same time quite easy. You arrive at the bottom in a bay, rappel another 5 m and then find the (steep) way back down the side of the rock (blue markings). Once at the top, head back to the ruins and then to the car.
