Summary: (machine translated) Long and hard descent due to its approach and development. We will need two cars and a lot of exercise but it will be worth it. Only for experienced canyoneers		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Possible except in very fattened areas. Then a long walk in the middle of the forest would be necessary.		
Access: (machine translated) By the N621 to Puerto de San Glorio. Here we will leave the access car. Going down to Potes, with 4x4 we can go to Ledantes by the Majada de Ledantes. Otherwise we continue down to Vada where we take the detour to the right to Ledantes. With only one car we will go directly to Ledantes.		
Approach: (machine translated) From San Glorio we take a track that goes to the Peña del Portillo, we will not have to climb it completely, we will pass to the other side at about 1950m and we will continue more or less horizontally (but always gaining height) under the Peña del Naranjo towards the pass of Robadorio. Here a path takes us down to the stream. With only one car we leave Ledantes by the track that goes up to Riofrío and to the refuge of Cubil, once here we will go down to the stream.		
Tour: (machine translated) Long descent, with a large number of abseilings and skills. Some of the rappels are difficult to access and access must be secured as they are quite delicate and slippery. Its intermediate section has almost 800m of horizontal progression and if we leave the riverbed to the left we will see a cattle cabin that could serve as a refuge.		
Return: (machine translated) After the last rappel we leave to the right by a path, cross the meadow and take the track that goes down to Ledantes.


