Summary: (machine translated) Canyon with some beautiful large pools. There are a few nice jumps - if you look carefully you will also find at least one 15 m jump.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We leave the SS 33 (Gravellona - Domodossola), which goes up the Ossola valley, through the exit of Piedimulera and we go west on the SS 549 in the Val d'Anza towards Macugnaga. After 10 km (from the SS 33 exit) we reach the village of Molini, where we leave our car and continue on foot, turning left immediately after the village. Crossing the Torrente Anza, we go uphill on a narrow road for 850 m, then we come to a bridge over the Val Segnara.		
Approach: (machine translated) On foot we continue, turning left immediately after the village. Across the Torrente Anza, we go uphill on a narrow road for 850 meters, then cross the bridge and immediately down to the right to the stream.		
Tour: (machine translated) Quite a wide canyon; somewhat slippery; when rappelling along the wall of the water drainage, the two pitons are only used as a safety measure to reach the chain anchor on the valley side, which is not visible from above. You can end the tour with a 13 m jump into the Torrente Anza. Here you can also use the large boulder to build a rope slide (2025)		
Return: (machine translated) About 50 meters downstream in the Anza, then out to the right on a fishing path and upstream on the covered canal to the bridge. At the church, cross the Anza through the village, cross the bridge again and return to the car.

Attention...always a bit slippery... At the top there are 2 parking lots in front of and behind the bridge. We didn't see an anchor at the steps under the bridge. You can also get off here. If you want to go further, jump orographic to the right of the watercourse. Then there is another abseiling point before the stream flows into the Anza. A high jump to the right is possible with a little jumping ahead. (machine translated)
