Relatively short rappel canyon with long and partly exposed access.

Access: (machine translated)

Same approach as to the Soffia or the Val Pisson (see there). We leave the car for the access at the north end of the Lago del Mis at the Bar alla Soffia, where then the road closed to non-residents begins as an access road for the Soffia (P1 - 430m altitude).\n\a second car we leave at the mouth of the stream from the Val Rui Biachi. To do this, we continue north along the road that brought us to P1, along the Torrente Mis - upstream. We pass the Val Costalunga descending from the left and after 2.7 km from P1 we come to a ruin on the right of the road in the immediate vicinity of the mouth of "our" stream in the Torrente Mis. Here we park the car for the exit (P2).

Approach: (machine translated)

From P1 we climb up the road as on the access to Soffia. We pass the houses of Gena Madia (570m altitude) and come up to Gena Alta at 800m altitude. Here we turn right (eastwards) to the entry to Soffia and Val Pisson. However, we take the little-used path that leads out of the hamlet in a north-westerly direction. At an altitude of 970m, an inconspicuous path turns off to the left from this path. It remains essentially horizontal and we enter a rocky ledge. We come to a grotto with a memorial plaque. We continue along the ledge, the path has slipped in places. It becomes increasingly exposed. The ledge finally exits at 1100m in a ditch - "(E)". The descent begins with 2 rappels, followed by a march down to an altitude of 850m.

Tour: (machine translated)

Here - "E"- begins a sequence of 11 rappels and some possible jumps. After a C25 with sharp edge and a C15 in ends the descent in a large pool.

Return: (machine translated)

After the big pool, head out along the creek to the road and the car at P2.
