<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Forest gorge with lush greenery and many rappels, no slides or possible jumps.

<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Pamplona in the direction of Huesca on the A21. After approx. 16 km we pass the last exit before Monreal. At the next exit, i.e. after Monreal, we leave the A21 onto the NA234 in a westerly direction. After a little more than 1 km on a narrow, straight road, you cross the Rio Elorz. Immediately after the bridge, turn left and take the new Canal de Navarra up to the hamlet of Yamo. Park the lower vehicle here by the church. The conventional access road to the canyon exit is still there, but is difficult to find after the road and canal construction work that has taken place here and cannot be mastered with a normal car. The second vehicle takes us back towards the A21. Before reaching the highway, we turn right and drive to Monreal. Turn right again there and follow the signs for Higa. We cross the Rio Elorz again (the medieval bridge on the right). After that, the road paths upwards. We follow the very evenly ascending road in a north-westerly direction and after a while it becomes steeper and suddenly turns almost 90 degrees to the south-west. Directly after this striking bend, there is a large pile of stones (760 m above sea level) to the right of the road. We park our vehicle here. If the track seems bad or impassable, we park our car beforehand. See the Google maps section in the photos in the gallery.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) At the cairn, clear tracks lead steeply down. A short step follows once, which can be rappelled. You reach the streambed directly at the 1st rappel, saving about 30 minutes in the streambed that the conventional access, which starts further up from the slope, would have entailed.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) 23 rappel, beautifully cut in the upper area, after the C 28 forest canyon, see photos and video		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the last rappel out left and along the edge of the field further along the stream to the dirt road by the bridge (former location of the lower vehicle). Here turn left. The dirt road and the following path to Yamo are part of the 'camino' to Santiago de Compostela. The pilgrim canyoneer takes the upper path at a fork, returning to the church in Yamo.

Done after Lizebar. Nice to do with water finally after a nightmarish experience years ago, bushwacking on the approach in May (catching 60+ ticks) flw by dry canyon. Since the pandemic, the place is flooded with tourists, there is a trail going steeply up: left bank along a field to last waterfall, cross, traverse right bank 100m along another field untill new trail (cairn) right, little bushy at first, then steeper, slippery + fixed ropes, to the original trail, and finally to the large trail to the top. Half way is intermediate access.

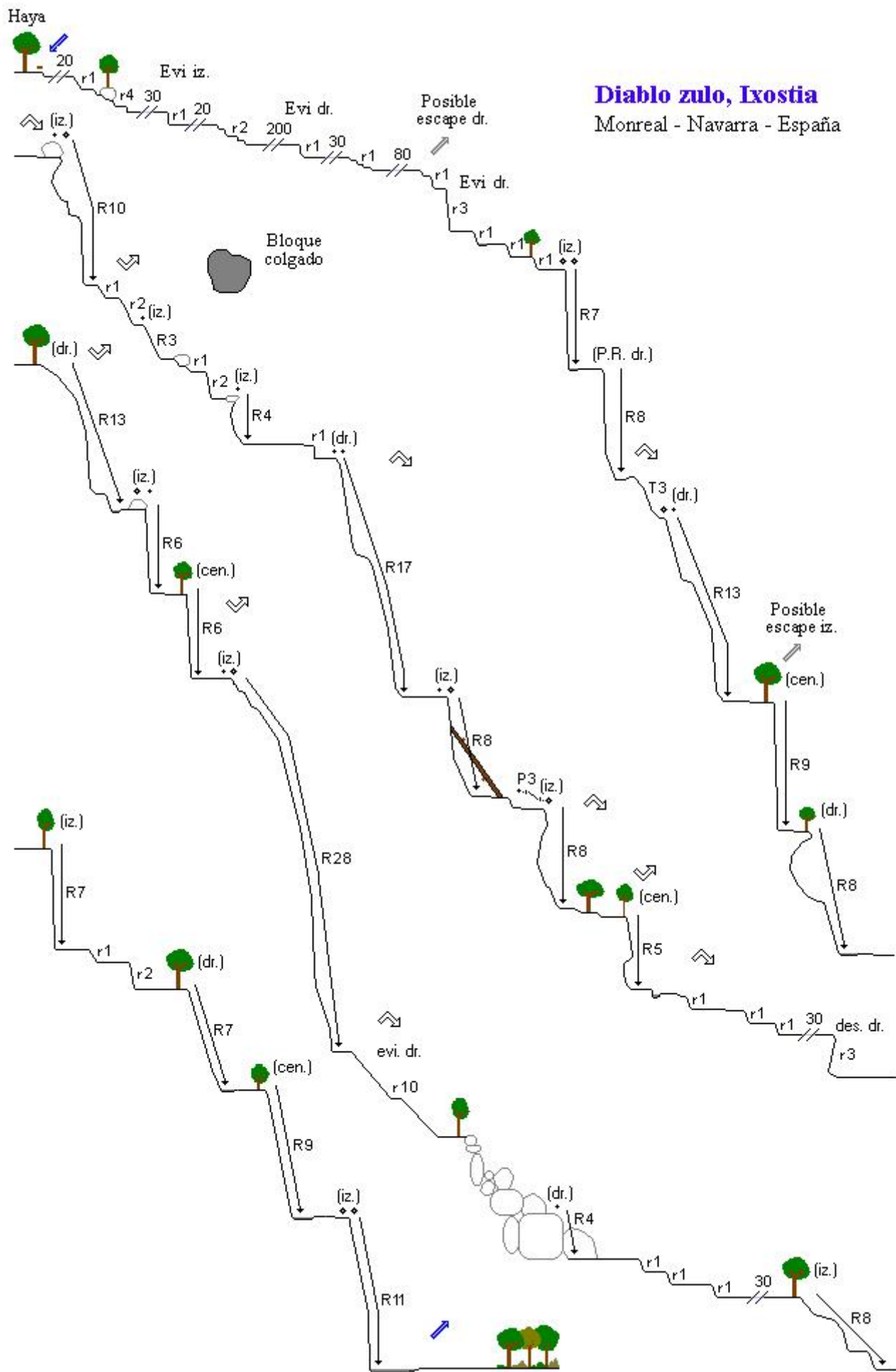
