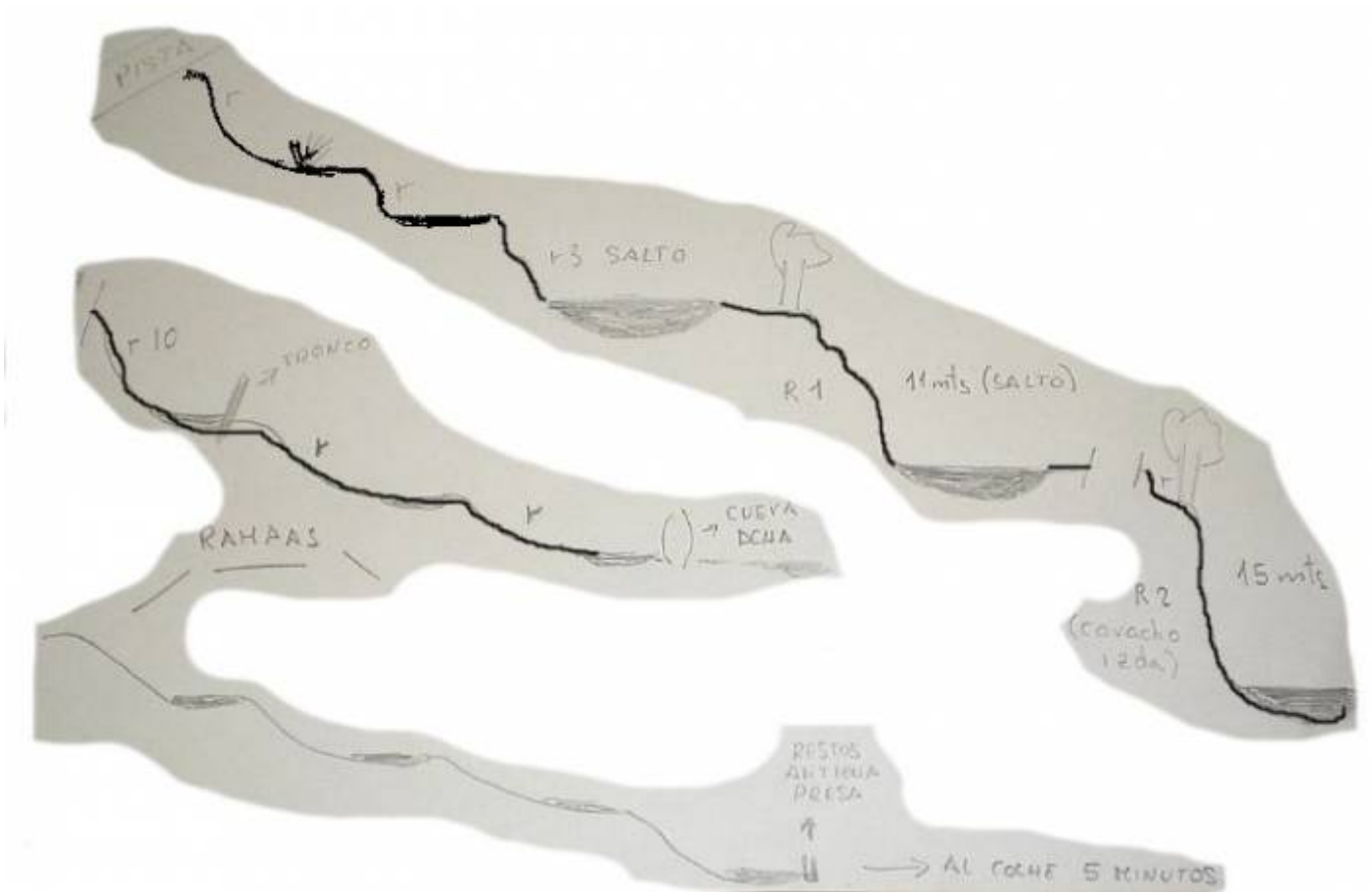

<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) O de los Moros is a simple but colorful descent that can be used to start practicing canyoning. In spring it allows enough jumps and the waterfalls are very picturesque. In summer it dries out and becomes less attractive.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) In most of the route, it is quite open		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We are located in Ainsa (N260), we will take the A138 towards France through the Bielsa tunnel. After a few kilometers we will pass through Labuerda and almost 3 kilometers later we have an electrical substation on the right, about 70m later an exit of the road to the left allows us to park at the exit of the ravine.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Following the track where we parked, we go up the ravine on the orographic left, with no other difficulty than to follow it until it crosses the stream.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Easy, if we do it after rain, it is a fun descent (for beginners) but with uninteresting sections.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) We arrived at an old dam and from there to the parking lot.
