### **Gear:**

Ropes: 2x25m

### **Summary:** (machine translated)

Slot canyon, usually without water flow. Entry via the lower parts of Wadi Safarin. The Mubarak Canyon has another tributary from the right, the Wadi Umm D'ohhe.

## **Hydrology:**

### **Access:** (machine translated)

From Petra on the Kings Highway "35" in the direction of Karak (north). After approximately 30 km we pass Shobak. 2 km further on we turn left in Al Jaya and drive past Shobak Castle and via Mansoura to the parking lot before a right-hand serpentine of the sloping road (see 2 Google maps map sections under "Links").

### **Approach:** (machine translated)

From the parking lot we take the path that leads us in a southeasterly direction to the entry, see Google Earth map section under "Gallery".

### **Tour:** (machine translated)

Many smaller drops, mostly for downclimbing, usually no water flow until the spring above the last rappel; but many pools. The descent ends when you reach the Wadi Ghuweir.

### **Return:** (machine translated)

In Wadi Ghuweir uphill until we get out onto the tarred road (prominent tree). On the road up to the car.
