Also known as Canal del Roure is a beautiful torrent with two sections, the first more open and grassy, the second between walls.

For the return we have to climb 3m of fixed rope, you must carry climbing equipment (fist, croll, ... ).

In the first part up to the track

**Access:** (machine translated)

We will leave Sant Llorenç de Morunys towards Berga on the LV-4241 road at kilometer 24 of the LV-4241 road, and before passing the river Aigua de Valls (Pont de Valls), there is a road on the left, which we will take.

Continue up the road, which leads to Vilacireres, pass it and Cal Pelegri to Cal Blanc. Here we turn right, we will have it very clear because it is a track between two stone walls. We will follow this one, which is the main one, leaving some on the sides until we pass under the power line. After it, about 150m to the next left turn where a track to the right. We park the access car.

If we have access car we will continue about 800m until a track that arrives on the right that is our return.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

It is easy to go down to the riverbed, at the beginning there is a lot of vegetation so we will go to the left.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Two parts:

The first of open character, without great difficulties, long but simple rappels that leave us on a track where we can leave or where we will return.

The second part is more closed, a beautiful gorge, with a lot of skills until we reach the river Aigua de Valls.

**Return:** (machine translated)

There would be the possibility of following the river to the Pont Cabradís (we would have to think about this combination of cars).

What is outlined here by the wikiloc track is to climb the second channel taking advantage of the marks and fixed ropes that allow us to go up it until we reach an almost lost track that is the one we cross between the first and second part of the ravine.

We will follow this track until we reach the main track where we park.

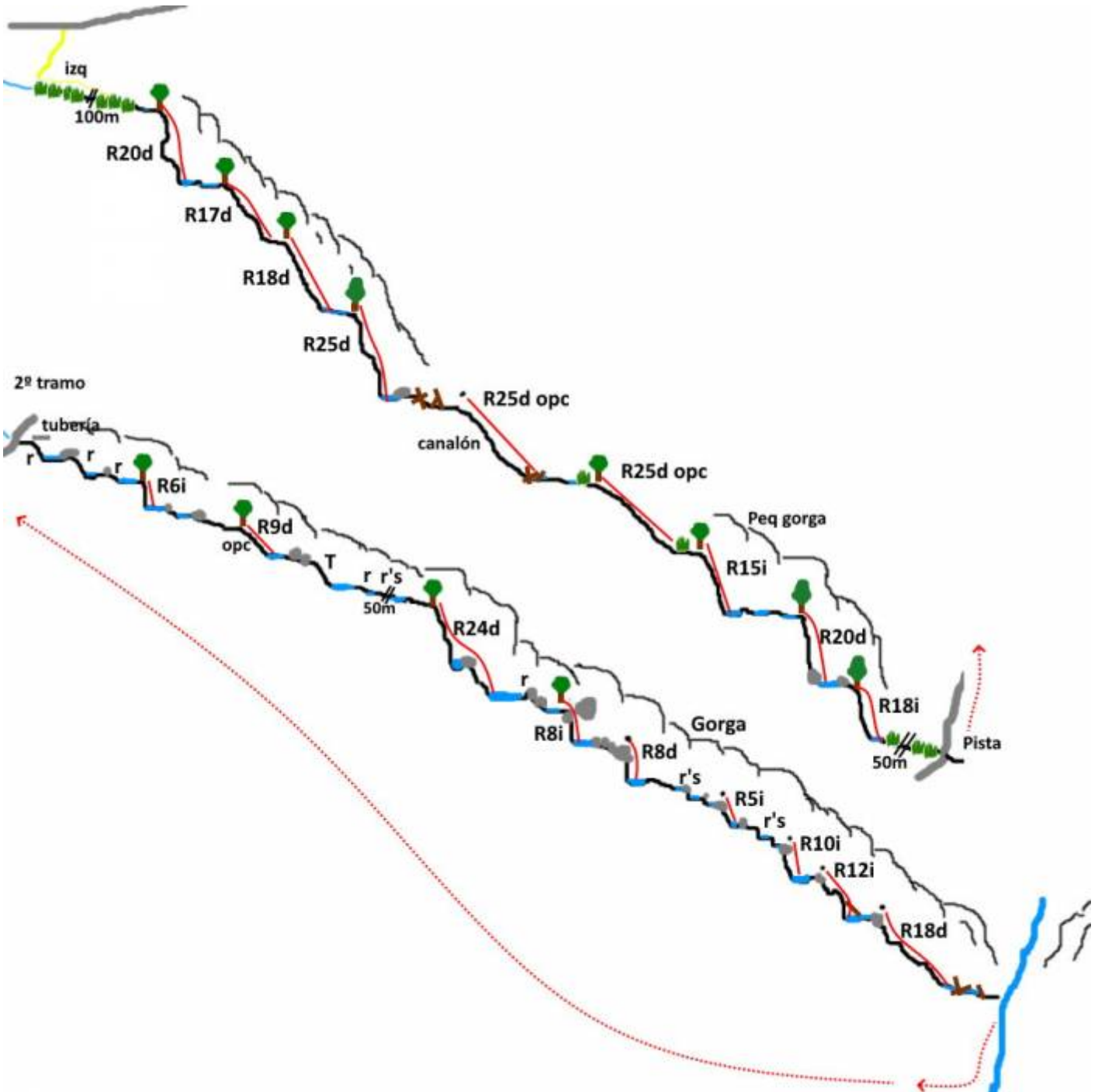
