Simple and short canyons that share the entire middle and final course. Entering by one there are 3 rappels and by the other 4, plus the common part.

Keep in mind that they are little frequented so they usually have a lot of vegetation, pruning shears can be a good idea.

Almost always we will find a trickle of water and in the rainy season it can have a good flow.

Access: (machine translated)

We are located in Berga on the C16 or in Solsona. In both cases you have to take the C26 that joins them.

In the p.k. 134.6 we have the detour by the camí de Trasserra, we will get into it and arrive at the house Torrades, we leave it on the right, we will see a very bad track also on the right, we ignore it and continue along the next one that is in better condition. The track continues to climb, getting into the forest and approaching the nearby mountains and their walls. After almost 2 kms there is a track in bad condition on the left, it is the exit track, if we have a high car we can leave it on this track arriving at the reservoir.

We will continue 1 km more until a bridge over a stream, here we will park in a couple of more open areas for about 3-4 cars.

Approach: (machine translated)

The access to Runers is immediate, we will go down to the riverbed and we will go by its orographic right until the beginning of the "hostilities".

For the access to Trasserra we will have to follow the track walking until a curve to the right where we will see a stone with a red mark and a milestone on the left. We will follow these milestones to the riverbed.

Tour: (machine translated)

Both Trasserra and Runers are more vertical in their first part, then they join and have shorter and easier rappels.

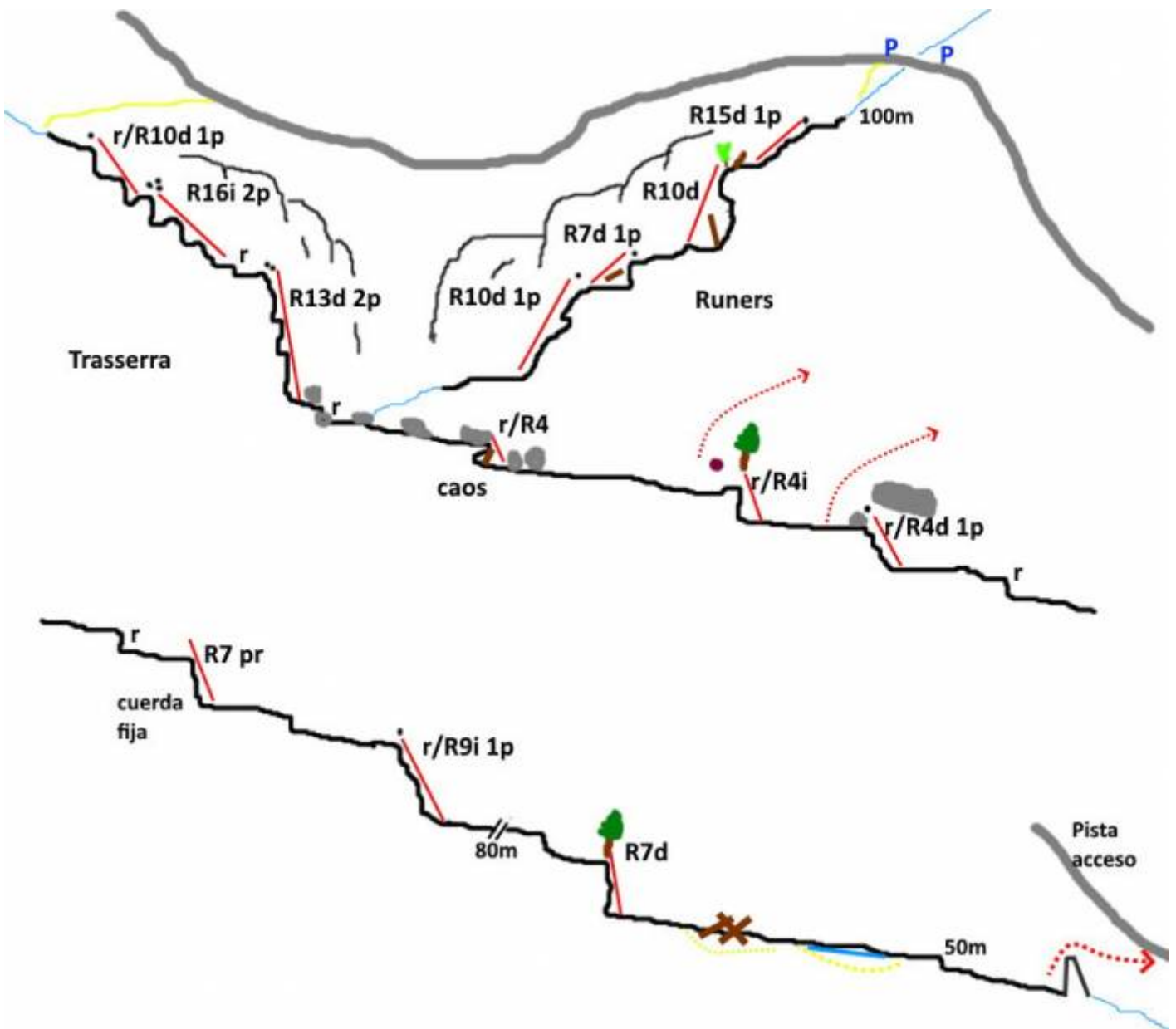
Return: (machine translated)
