**Summary:** (machine translated)

Short rappel canyon with relatively long access in a lonely area.

### Hydrology:

#### Access: (machine translated)

From Castellane on the Verdon (there from Nice on the N 85 - Route Napoleon - about 100 km) on the N 85 in the direction of Digne (north-west) we drive up to the Col de Leque in many hairpin bends, pass a rock gate where the Clue de Taulanne, which is forbidden for canyonists, begins on the left below and drive down again in many hairpin bends to la Tuillère (from Castellane to here 16 km). Just before the village, we turn left onto the D 21 and drive 6 km up to Blieux. We continue (northwest) on the D 21 towards the houses of Le Bas Chaudoule. Almost exactly 2 km after Blieux (village center), we see a signpost on the left-hand side of the road for "Portail de Blieux" and "Le Chiran". We park the car here.

### **Approach:** (machine translated)

We follow the signposted path in a curve around the estate on the left ("propriété privée") and then steadily up the mountain. At a saddle, you can already see the rock breakthrough quite clearly. Continuing up the path - occasionally marked in yellow - we come to a narrow rock cut, after which the path turns right. Now we have to descend pathlessly to the left down to the stream. The author has gone quite far and descended relatively far up the opposite slope into the streambed. Looking back (directly and figuratively), it would perhaps be better to look for a direct descent from the isolated rock needle on the left below the path into the stream to the left of the ditch that runs down to the stream beyond the rock needle.

#### **Tour:** (machine translated)

If you don't want to slide in over the wide rock at the start of the descent, there is a bush above for the rope attachment. This is followed by 5 smaller rappels without running sections.

The water quickly becomes cloudy due to the suspended particles in the water.

## Return: (machine translated)

After the last rappel, continue along the streambed until you reach the main stream. Cross it and then take the road on the left to the car.

Alternatively, we can exit to the left at the exit of the descent and head left along the flat area to the access path. Follow this back to the car.
