Summary: (machine translated) Canyon with little water except in spring and autumn that the stream can be even strong. Its final 60m rappel is spectacular! You can do this rappel alone or do the canyon up to here. There is a path at the head of the canyon to leave the 60m ropes there and not have to carry them... multiple possibilities for a beautiful canyon. If we do it whole it is better to leave the car at the bottom, if not we can leave it in Frades and before the waterfall of 60m leave by the path on the right to return to the village. It is better to avoid the summer because of the heat and because if it dries out the marmites can be rotten.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) At all times		
Access: (machine translated) We will have to go to La Sénia by the CV105 towards Frades, when crossing the bridge of the reservoir of Ulldecona, we will see a track on the right by which we will go up with the car. After passing the tail of the reservoir we will have a fork, on the right the Bco de Fou, we will continue on the left. We will continue along the track until we can no longer continue.		
Approach: (machine translated) From this same point the path that goes up to Frades leaves. After passing the 60m waterfall we have on the right a path to access the head of the Salt de Robert, here we can leave the ropes of 60 if we do not want to go loaded. We will continue ascending towards the town, when we go sighting it, we will see a path to the right that goes out towards the river. Here we access

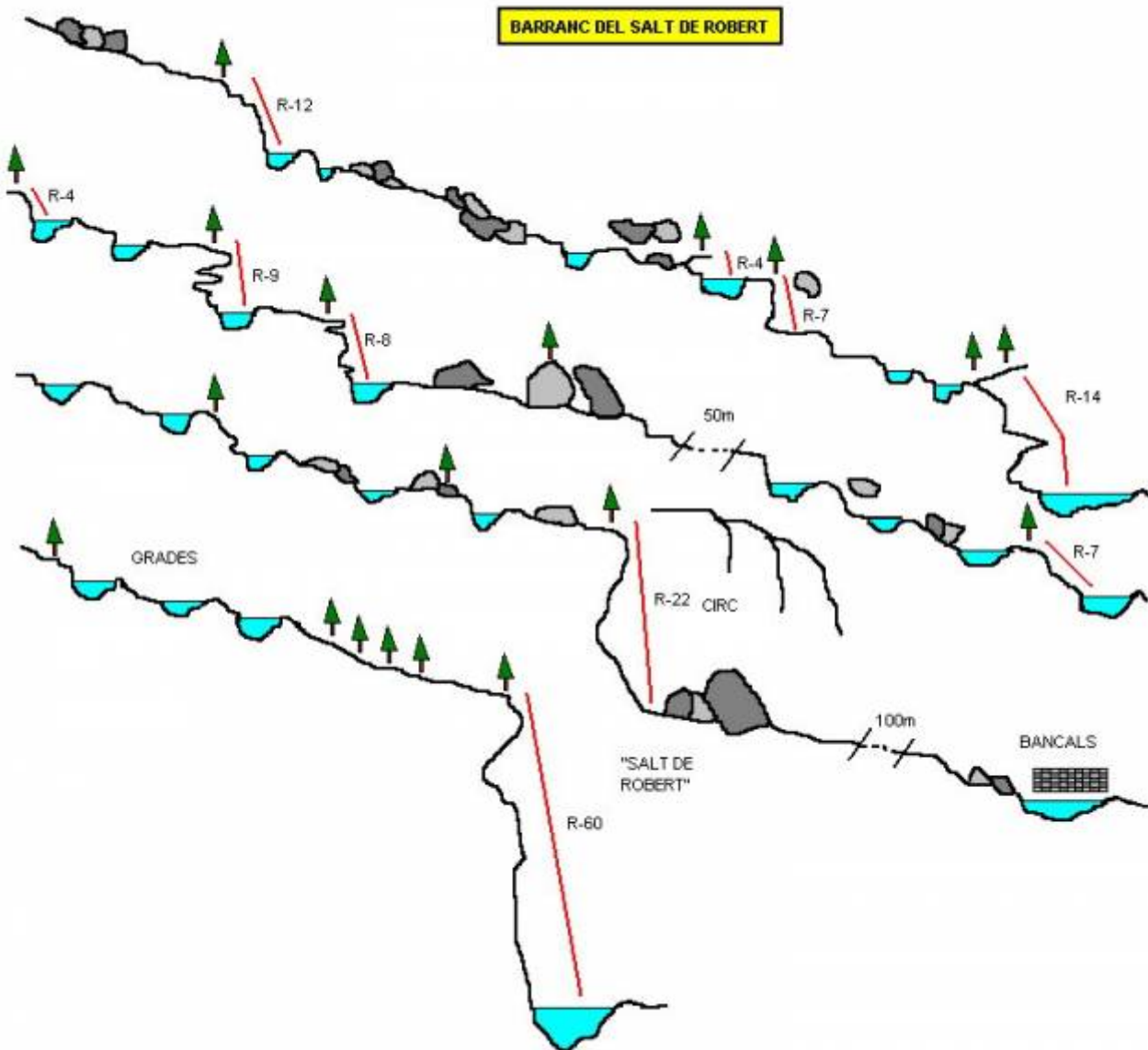
