Along the IP valley route to take the PR28 towards the Collarada. After just over an hour we will leave the trail and continue without losing altitude on a poorly defined path that heads south.

We will follow this path until we are again above Canfranc, when we see a fairy chimney we will know that we are in our ravine.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Wild descent, with a lot of cliffs, vegetation and uninteresting areas. Very spectacular in its first section in which we will descend 100m chaining rappels.

Along the railway track to the left towards the halt. After it we have a path that goes down to Canfranc, when we get almost to the bottom we must follow the river going up the pylons until we reach the car.
