How to get to Valle del Gran Rey

We will need two cars to get to Valle del Gran Rey.

The return car we will have to go down to La Calera and from here to Argaga beach where we will park.

With the access car we will have to go up the valley towards Arure, soon we will arrive at Los Granados and just at the exit there is a detour to the right to Los Hornillos and Chele, we get in here, cross the ravine and when going up, in the left curve we have the Chele Street on the right we get in and go to the end where we will park.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

We go straight ahead on the path of the kings, after 500m we have a detour that we take to the left to go up the mountain. When we reach the pass we will see our ravine below us. We will follow the path until we see the possibility of descending directly to the riverbed.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

A small small gorget with abseiling, then another gorget with the first abseil to start the most interesting part, a well formed gorget with an 80m waterfall divided into 60+20 and then another 45m. A quieter section with narrow passages to reach the last gorget with another magnificent 48m abseil.

We will follow the ravine to the beach

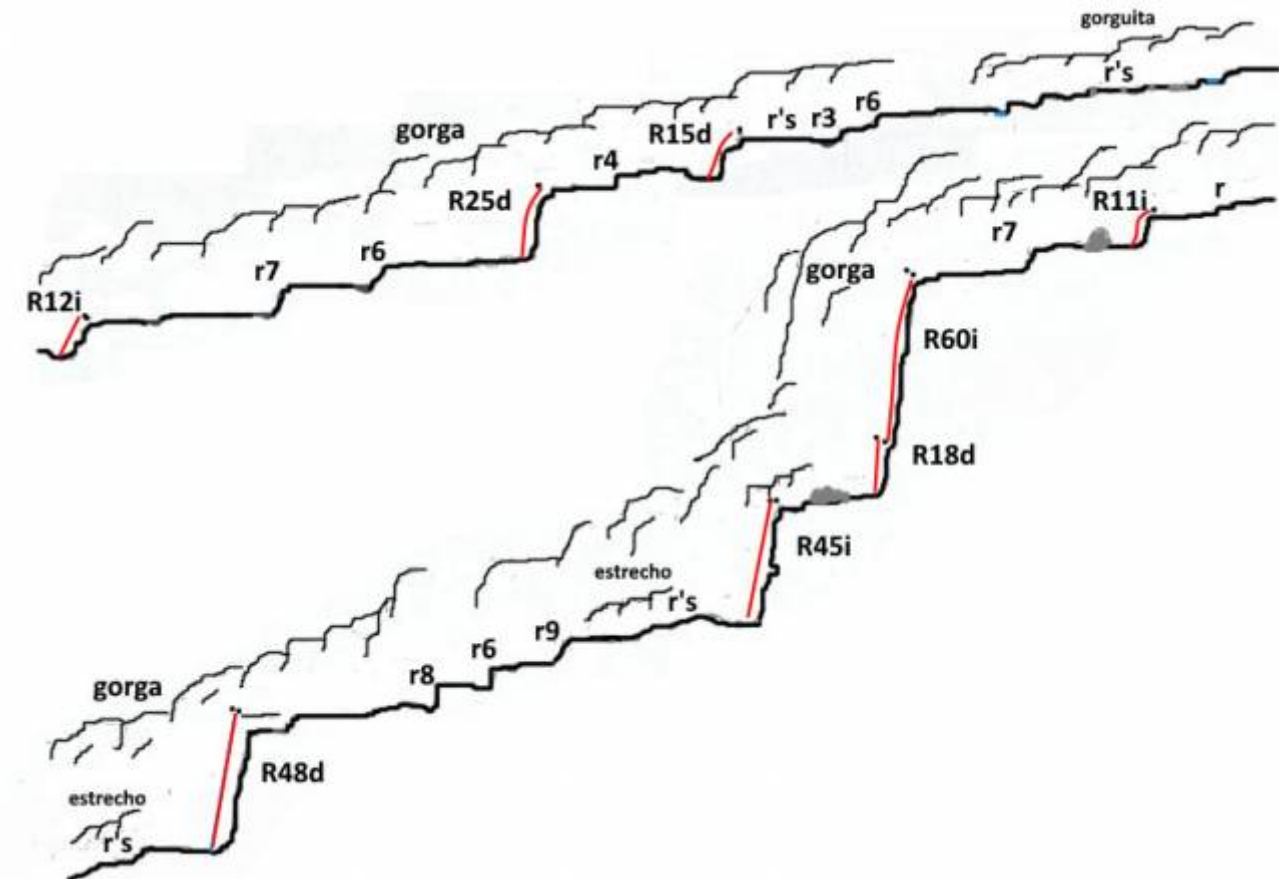
