Summary: (machine translated) Narrow, winding, with lots of vegetation on both sides. This unique descent, whose maximum difficulty is its long extension, is divided into two sections by the road and will force us to combine cars, unless we do both parts separately. After the confluence with the Leiras we will finish our descent. Descent that we will be able to make to initiate new people as long as the flow is the correct one. A very interesting option is to do only the lower part, more vertical, in which case we can do it with only 1 vehicle and walk 2kms along the road.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Yes, especially on the bridge that divides the two parts. Direct exit to the highway		
Access: (machine translated) We have to get to Valadouro We will go south on the LU-P-0101 towards O Cadramón, at the height of p.k. 25 we have on the left Freixido, where we will leave the return car. With the access car we continue two kilometers more until the detour to the right to Cortegaza, we leave it behind and after a right fork we will find a crossroads, we will go left, uphill towards the wind farm, a few meters there is a Canadian pass (antiganado) and a track on the left. We park here without getting in the way.		
Approach: (machine translated) We will go down the track to the riverbed. If we only do the lower part, we must walk along the road to the bridge over the river and access it by the orographic left.		
Tour: (machine translated) See all The first part of the route is more flat, with only 4 rappels and a lot of walking areas. The second part more vertical		
Return: (machine translated) After the confluence with Leiras, a power line, a place to go up to the village.
