Open ravine, little traveled, with plenty of vegetation. Like the rest of Gredos is carved in granite and has many possibilities of escape. It does not have a great interest unless it carries a good flow so it is a good option for spring.

The opening sketch is included but today the facilities are somewhat different, provide spare material, ropes and a few meters of rope just in case.

**Access:** (machine translated)

Getting to Candeleda on the CL501.

By the orographic right of the river we will go up looking for the street of the Jarra, when leaving the village it becomes a forest track in good condition. From the exit of the village it is just over 5kms. Here we will leave the return car or if we only have one vehicle.

With the access car we will continue along the track towards the Albarea refuge and shortly before arriving (about 5kms of track) we have a track on the left, it is a very tight turn, we will follow this track in worse condition another 5kms until a right turn where a track comes out in front, just to our left we have our ravine.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

If we have access vehicle we will only have to go down to the stream.

From the return car we will have to go up the slope, by the orographic left of the river, we will look for a firebreak that leads us to another larger firebreak, we will follow it up to the track above. We take this track to the left and arrive at the upper parking point.
