Jump, slide canyon - dry towards the exit in summer. It is the third of 3 parts. The middle part starts at the road bridge (see 50 CANYONS IN CENTRAL GREECE-

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From the highway No. 1 Athens - Thessaloniki between Larissa and Lamia exit and continue in the direction of Volos. From here at the western foot of the peninsula Pilion along the Pagasitikos gulf, past Agria and Lehonía up to the junction in the direction of Milies approx. 2.5km to Kala Nera (from Volos 18 km). Continue via Milies to Tsagarada (22 km). Here the road branches off to Mylopotamos with its beautiful beach. 3.5 km after this turnoff, a dirt road turns off to the right (south); follow it for a few hundred meters to a plateau where you park your car. If you have a second vehicle, park it at the end of the road above Mylopotamos beach (restaurant by the sea).

Approach: (machine translated)

From the plateau go downhill on a track in a southerly direction, then pathless first over a cleared forest area (keeping slightly half-right), later over a boulder field down to the river

Tour: (machine translated)

Attractive canyon with many jumps (e.g. C7, C8, C10 - rope traverse there) and slides; is also commercially visited. George Andreou, the author of the mentioned book lives in Volos and is happy to give a guided tour through 'his' special canyon. He is also happy to give more information about other canyons. Because of some forced passages in the watercourse pay attention to moderate water level! C7, T2, T2, T3, C5, C8, C10, C3, T3, T4, T3, T7, T4, T4, 200 m run, T3, T3, T3, 100 m run, C14, 500 m run)

Return: (machine translated)

About 200 m before the sea, turn right on a path towards the sea, then left over a footbridge and - passing a chapel - left up the stairs to the parking lot of the lower vehicle. From here to the upper parking 4 km.
