Summary: (machine translated) Short, quite vertical canyon with 110 m final (30 /80)		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) A13 exit 15 (Zizers). Continue to Trimmis. Parking facilities near Trimmis Platz. Park 1 car there. Continue by 2 cars in the direction of Says to Valtanna.		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the hiking trail towards Talein (signs), past a large meadow. At the exit of the meadow near a building, follow the hiking trail to the right down to the river. The path crosses the river and follows it to the first slide brake. Get in here.		
Tour: (machine translated) Five rappels, 2 of them at barrages, some rather small slides. Also geologically beautiful canyon, beautiful rock. The highlight is the c110 separated into two steps of 30 and 80 meters.		
Return: (machine translated) Leave the canyon at Mühlenweg. A few meters to Trimmis Platz

Orographic right intermediate belay damaged during the big rappel, which is why we took the left one. Ans. Relatively good stances but a bit loose. A wrench for retightening is almost a must. We also had it with us and tightened the stances we used. (machine translated)
