By the TF82 between Guía de Isora and Adeje, at the height of p.k. 45 in Tijoco, we have the detour to the TF585 towards Tijoco Alto. On this road we will go up to the hamlet and once there we will go up to the new tank where we will park the access vehicle.

The return vehicle from Tijoco Alto instead of turning right we will go left about 500m to the end of the road.


