At p.k. 101, just before the detour to Arén, we have the detour to the right to Orrit and Sapeira. At 3 kilometers from Sapeira, in a left curve of the road, there is a track in front of Esplugafreda.

Arriving there we will continue along the track towards the Tossal de l'Abadia and the Tossal Ras... About 9km.

Park before reaching the bend that makes the track around the Llau Fonda, our ravine, which in this first section takes that name.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Either along the same dry creek or about 100m before along a small path that goes down to the riverbed.

A first gorget and then two circuses, another small gorget to finish with

After the last rappel there is a long walk before taking the losing path that climbs to the Collada de la Roca de la Mola. When we reach the top we will find a track that we must follow first in an easterly and then northerly direction, enjoying the views of our ravine all the time.
