<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Short descent, only 500m long, but quite vertical, in which we will descend more than 300m in a series of rappels and rappels (some of them "delicate") continuous and without rest. Technical and very entertaining descent. It can be considered that the canyon has two sections, the upper more open and less attractive and the lower more boxed and aesthetic with a succession of chained rappels. The companies in the area offer them independently as lower or integral. Pay attention to the length of the rappels of the first section, because if you use the existing facilities to perform some "delicate" skills you need a 40m rope (rappels up to 20m). In summer the upper part usually dries out, keeping water in the pools of the lower section.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Not in the closed part, but it is difficult to have problems with the flow, except for very heavy rains.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Getting to Arenas de Cabrales on the AS-114 road. Towards Panes, just outside Arenas, the road crosses the river Cares. Next to the bridge, before crossing, on the left there is a small road that forks after 100m. We will go to the right to follow the track that runs parallel to the Cares to the fish farm and park.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We will return to the previous junction and shortly before reaching the cheese factory a track to the right goes backwards that soon becomes a path. The path takes us up the mountain for about 300m and finally heads east, passing some rocky walls and getting into the channel / creek that we will soon go down. When we reach the bridge over the stream we access.
