Summary: (machine translated) Ravine regulated by the Encoro reservoir on the river Conselo. It maintains a fairly constant flow except at times of release due to rainfall. It is necessary to be informed in order not to catch one of its floods that can make it dangerous. Its headwaters are quite exposed.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Almost any time. It is quite open		
Access: (machine translated) We have to go to Vilarino de Conso. To do this by the A52 exit in A Gudiña and take the OU-533 or OUR-CU-346. It takes the same time and there are the same curves. Once in the village we have several options: 1 Car next to the village, we can leave it in the square or go to the right along the concrete track and park at the exit about 100m there is a lay-by. 1 car on the road near the entrance wall, for this we continue the concrete track to the road to Castiñeira and where we can park. 2 cars, one we leave in the village and the other we go up the track to the bridge that crosses the river.		
Approach: (machine translated) Once on the Castiñeira road, we can enter through the wall taking advantage of the steel cable and we remove the first skills or go to the bridge and do that part.		
Tour: (machine translated) Very varied descent with exposed headwaters and duplicated installations to avoid the active. It is advisable to carry more rope to ensure access to the headwaters.		
Return: (machine translated) If we have left the car in the village we leave by the water catchment by a little marked path. Soon it becomes a path that leaves us in the village. If we have the car on the road we can go up on the left side of the road, walking a little bit on the left side.
