must be done partly by a runway.

Either Cedro(s) med. "upstream" (for access at E1 or E2 cf. then there) or from P3 on the trail PR3SJO down to E3, see Google aerial photo in "Photo Gallery".

**Return:** (machine translated)

Arrived at the coast, you have theoretically 3 possibilities:\n1. Pick up by boat (must be organized; only possible in calm seas)\n2. Along the coast in a westerly direction. This involves swimming a short distance (about 30m) during high tide, which is also only possible when the sea is calm. Also during low tide a passage at the waterline can be impossible in stronger swell. In this case the only option is to climb over the rocks. This is not easy, also because the ground is slippery. When you reach the mouth of the Cavaletes at the houses, take the trail PR3SJO to the right (eastward) up to P3, (the second section is then identical to the approach trail).\n3. The 3rd possibility of an exit with return is identical to the second with the difference that upon reaching the mouth of the Cavaletes at the houses, the trail PR3SJO is continued in a westerly direction close to the coast until you reach the car at P4.
