Summary: Canyon section between the dam and climbing sector that despite the beautiful water colours of the dam, does not deliver the same goods. A few abseils, but most of all walking with vegetation or the occasional landslide precede the more narrow part. A water canal and before you know it, you have arrived back at the climbing crag.		
Hydrology: Large water capture above.		
Access: Park the lower car at climbing sector Val Gallina. Drive up to the dam with bike or car. Alternatively walk the concrete access road.		
Approach: Access the valley floor best way possible, mind the large water pipe, where the dam could potentially do an (automated) flushing.
