Nice canyon to combine with Gulp although it is difficult to catch it with good flow. This canyon is really two parts and a tributary that can be combined in several ways. The part of the Forns is the most vertical, Fuiet is the tributary and the final part, in the fattening is the Grau de la Plana.

On the C-13 from Tremp to Pobla de Segur we arrive at Talarn. Just at the entrance we turn left towards Gulp. Situation bcos Avellanes, Forns, Fuiet, Grau de la Plana

Just before reaching the village there is a sharp right turn on the Grau ravine, we can park here or 200m later, we will find a track that goes off to the right, here there is room to park.

Approach: (machine translated)

Bcos Avellanes, Forns, Fuiet, Grau de la Plana

We will continue walking to the village and we will get into the left street by the cemetery to the top of these 4 boxes, we will find indicators to the Collada de Castellet, we will go along this path that climbers use to access the walls.

Once in the girdle we will walk about 250m until we see a small zigzagging path to our right that goes up, leaving the main trail below (it goes to the escape before the R4), we will cross the next girdle and the path will lead us towards NW towards the head of Forns.

Tour: (machine translated)

Three nice rappels before the escape, from here we could go up to Fuiet, but we would miss the R20, we better go down it and go out to the right to go up to the trail. We will follow the trail about 150m to the point where the two streams meet, here we start Fuiet to go down again the end of R4. From here the Grau de la Plana with two more rappels.

We continue walking along the creek for about 150m until we reach the road.

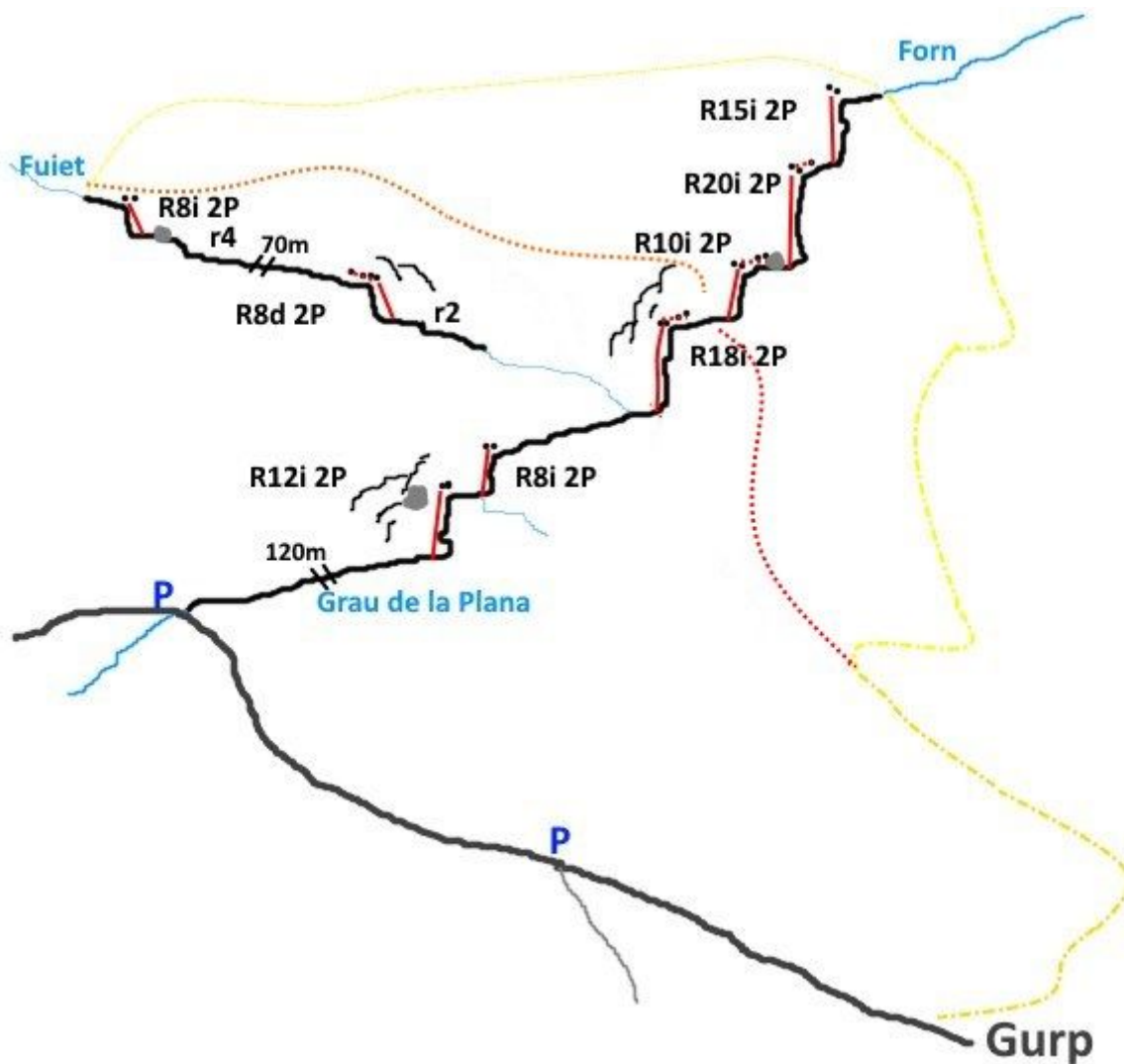
