Summary: (machine translated) Narrow slot canyon a few meters below the surface. Autumn canyon, very cold water. Raw data import from Descente Canyons https://www.descente-canyon.com/canyoning/canyon/22570		
Hydrology: (machine translated) The catchment area appears small, but consists mainly of the north face of the Eiger and therefore usually has too much water or ice.		
Access: (machine translated) Wengernalpbahn to Alpiglen, note that there is another Alpiglen in Grindelwald on the other side of the Große Scheidegg.

Tour: (machine translated) The canyon quickly becomes very narrow. Mostly just below the surrounding boulder fields and meadows. Two higher steps (30m), one of which is the waterfall you passed on the access. Many narrow climbing sections in the best rock. Be careful with too much water, it is not only cold but also mostly compressed.		
Return: (machine translated) Follow the hiking trail back to Alpiglen and take the train down to Grindelwald
