Anchor monopoint, but very good. Some searching in places. Overall sparsely drilled, but works at "normal" water level (which is already ample). Some downclimbs are tricky. 1x AN and 1x rappel on the old weir crown on the metal. Grip mostly very good, except for the crux at the beginning. Be sure to stay on the rope to set up the next ropes. Panic exes and good height are an advantage ;-) There is a lot of wood in the lower third, which is also helpful for downclimbing. The canyon and rock formations are very impressive. Steep access, but a picture book! (machine translated)
