Collector descent, with almost no facilities except for some spit, the rest from natural. We can combine vehicles and take advantage to continue the day of Fumanya and / or Sant Corneli. Dry except for heavy rains. Another descent of the list of EGAN (for more info contact them).

By the C16 from Berga to Puigcerda. We will pass Cercs and in Rodonella we can leave the car to return. Access Bcos Sant Corneli

We will continue and before p.k. 108 we have the detour to the left to St Josep and St Cornelli by the BV4025, for 5kms on this road to turn left to Fígols. We will pass these houses and continue until a very sharp left curve that has a track in front and a signpost with the PRs of the area (1.5 kms from the BV4025). We will get on the track towards the Torrent de la Fumanya for 700m to reach a right curve and another track in worse condition in front, we can park next to the remains of buildings (same as for Fumanya).

If we see the track in good condition we can continue, cross the riverbed and continue 1km towards El Morral, here we have a sharp right curve with a track on the left, park without disturbing.

Almost arriving at Fumanya we can take a path to the right that leads to the GR, to the right to the Rodonella or to the left to go up if we only have one vehicle.

Another option is to follow a few more steps to reach the Fumanya.


