<b>Resumen:</b> (traducción alternativa) Nice cave / canyoning tour with spectacular final abseil		
<b>Hidrología:</b> (traducción alternativa) Water comes from karst spring / from the cave		
<b>Acceso:</b> (traducción alternativa) Located directly on the SP76, there is a large parking lot at Tratorria From here you can already see the last cascades. From here you can shuttle towards the access path by car (or walk along the road)		
<b>Acceso:</b> (traducción alternativa) At N 46.394503 E 13.442089 a path branches off to the right. Follow this for about 20 minutes until you are directly in front of the cave entrance (karst spring exit).> N 46.391686 E 13.435678 There are a few parking spaces along the road near the start of the path; you could take a shuttle and save a few minutes' walk		
<b>Recorrido:</b> (traducción alternativa) You can either start the canyoning tour "downstream" or take a quick look into the cave. At the beginning you have to overcome a short/cold swimming section. Then you go into the cave for a few more minutes (headlamp !!) before continuing for cave divers only. The canyoning tour consists of 7-8 rappels (up to 25m), mostly from trees, before you reach the final rappel on the left (60m). Follow the hiking trail back to the parking lot for about 5 minutes An old entry from the AIC site describes that you can continue along the stream to the parking lot (+ 2 short rappels).		
<b>Regreso:</b> (traducción alternativa) 5 min along the hiking trail (or follow the stream - but we did NOT do this)

The cave is a nice start, the middle is unique, the finale is rather technical. Rigging should be revised, reaching the last anchor is actually dangerous (exposed climb high on slippery rock far to the left, if belayed from the one before, 40m rope will go out). 60m rope for the last rappel is very tight, 65m recommended.

First into the cave; one belay newly drilled, the rest mostly over trees or simple belays. The belaystation for the last 60m rappel was a good chain anchor far to the left (we built ourselves a rope traverse). (traducción alternativa)
